PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

The Public Schools NSW Strathfield and Canterbury Principals Network Awards are an opportunity to celebrate the achievements of staff and community members within our schools. The award ceremony was held last Thursday night at Homebush Boys High School. This year our awards went to Hailey Sutton, Classroom Teacher Award, and Jackie Speak,

Community Member Award. Hailey and Jackie contribute so much to the school community and this was a wonderful opportunity to show our appreciation.



Yesterday we had great weather for the Croydon Public Markets. As usual, there was a terrific selection of stalls, rides, delicious food and entertainment. An enormous amount of time and effort goes into organising such an event and I would like to thank the members of the P&C Social and Fundraising committee and the many volunteers who helped not only on Sunday but also on Friday and Saturday to set up. The donations of cakes and goodies for the Lucky Lottery were very much appreciated.

Last Tuesday, as everyone would be aware, a tragic accident occurred at Banksia Road Public School. For this tight knit community it will take some time for them to recover and for the families and staff directly involved they may never fully recover. In light of this accident, I believe it is timely for all Croydon PS community members to seriously reflect on their behaviour before and after school on the roads surrounding our school. Every day I see parents and carers do thoughtless, inconsiderate and dangerous things in their cars whilst dropping off and picking up children. I have seen so many "near misses" because of impatience and haste. We still have parents who stop and park either side of the crossing and, at times, on the crossing to drop off their children. This endangers both their own children and others. Parents also let their children out on the road to walk between parked cars where a driver could unwittingly reverse into them. Poor role modelling from adults who instead of using the pedestrian crossing will cross the road with their children between cars. I seriously ask all community members to be proactive about road and pedestrian safety

for the sake of our children and hopefully some change in behaviour at our school comes from the tragedy at Banksia Road PS.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING

2018 SCHOOL STUDENT TRANSPORT SCHEME AND TERM BUS PASS TRAVEL

Applications for 2018 School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) and Term Bus Pass (TBP) travel entitlements are now open.

In coming days students who hold an SSTS entitlement and are changing grade bands i.e. going from year 2 to 3 or year 6 to 7 <u>and</u> <u>changing school</u>, and students whose entitlement was approved under a medical condition, will receive notification by email or post informing them of the pending expiry of their entitlement. TBP holders will also receive notification.

Students enquiring about pending cancellation should be advised to go online to

<u>https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDet</u> <u>ails</u> to update details/make application for next year's entitlement.

Application needs to be made before 31 December 2017 to ensure their entitlement is updated and their current card is not cancelled. If application is made after the expiry of their entitlement (31 December) the system will automatically cancel their card and a new one will need to be issued.

Please note: Students who are changing grade band and are <u>remaining at the same school</u> will not receive notification and <u>do not need to</u> <u>reapply</u> (the system now automatically validates a student's on-going eligibility if at the same school and going from infants to primary or primary to secondary). Where a student meets the new eligibility the system will automatically update their entitlement and card.

Students in the Opal area applying for a SSTS or TBP entitlement for the first time will receive their card (posted to the nominated address) a week or two before the commencement of 2018 classes. Please note that new cards for 2018 are not posted in 2017 or during the Christmas / New Year period.




